

## Dreamweaver / WebDAV --New Uploading URL!

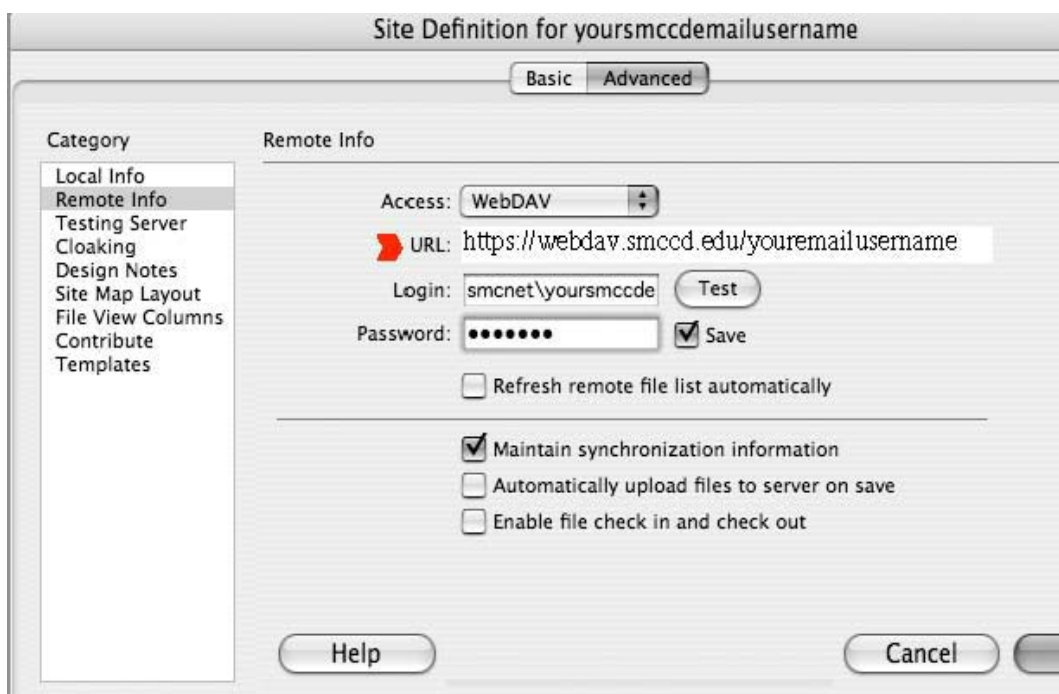
If you find you can't connect to your WebDAV/Dreamweaver folder, please use the following simple instructions to adjust your WebDAV URL address. First example below is for Dreamweaver users; second example is for Internet Explorer 8 WebDAV users.

Click on "Remote Info" in the Category window (see below), and fill in the "Remote Info" at right:

- Server Access, Choose "WebDAV"; Uncheck "Enable file check in and check out."
- For URL, enter "webdav.smccd.edu/*your\_smccd\_email\_username*"
- For Username, enter "smcnet\*your\_smccd\_email\_username*"
- For Password, enter your smccd.net email password and leave "Save Password" checked.
- Click OK. Site window appears.

Done! You should now be able to connect to your WebDAV / DW sites.

If you are on Internet Explorer 8 then the option to open as a web folder has been removed by Microsoft. If you are using Windows Vista on IE 8 here are the new instructions:

- 1) Open "My Computer".
- 2) Under the "Tools" menu select "Map Network Drive".
- 3) Click on the link "Connect to a Web site that you can use to store your documents and pictures".
- 4) Go through the "Add Network Location Wizard". Click "Next".
- 5) Be sure to select "Choose a custom network location" instead of "MSN Communities".
- 6) Put in your Webdav address for the Internet or network address:  
<https://webdav.smccd.edu/foldername>. Click "Next".
- 7) Enter your entire email address and email password for authentication.
- 8) Give it any name you want.
- 9) You can double-click on this folder/drive the next time you want to access your files.
