

Verifying Your WebAccess Course Shell

(Note: When using WebAccess, PC users use Int. Explorer or Firefox browser. Mac users use Firefox, not Safari)

Welcome!

To verify access to your WebAccess course shell* please do the following:

- Go to: <http://smccd.mrooms.net>
- **Log in** using your **G number** and **6-digit birth date**, no spaces/hyphens–MMDDYY.



- Once logged in, you should see links at left for your course(s). Click the link for the course you wish to enter. (Gray links indicate your course is hidden from students until you make the course available to them.)
- After clicking the link to your course you're taken to your WebAccess home page. That's it; you've verified access! Close your browser. You're done for now.
